 - (a) the authority granted under this resolution shall expire five years after the passing of this resolution; and
 - (b) the Company may, before such expiry under paragraph (a) above of this resolution, make an offer or agreement which would require shares to be allotted or rights to subscribe for or to convert any security into shares to be granted after such expiry and the directors may allot such shares or grant such rights (as the case may be) in pursuance of such offer or agreement notwithstanding that the authority conferred by this resolution has expired.

This authority is in addition to all subsisting authorities.

2. THAT, subject to Resolution 1 above being passed and in accordance with Articles 12.2 of the Articles, the directors be generally empowered to allot equity securities (as defined in section 560 of the Act) pursuant to the authority conferred by Resolution 1, as if the pre-emption rights arising under Article 12 of the Articles or otherwise did not apply to the allotment and issue of shares or the grant of rights to subscribe for or to convert any security into shares, made by the directors pursuant to the authority conferred upon them pursuant to Resolution 1 above.
