- 2 Liquidator's actions since appointment
- 2.1 This report should be read in conjunction with my receipts and payments account which is attached as Appendix 1; please note that the figures are shown net of VAT.
- 2.2 My receipts and payments account confirms that asset realisations have been in line with the declaration of solvency. Greater detail is provided below.

Asset

Cash at Bank

2.3 Upon closure of the Company's bank account held at HSBC Bank PLC, the credit balance in the sum of £60,020.41 was realised.

Tax Matters

- 2.4 On 8 December 2022, I was notified by HM Revenue and Customs that a pre appointment VAT return had remained outstanding for the period 1 January 2022 to 1 March 2022. Since receiving this notification, I have arranged for the outstanding VAT return to be filed.
- 2.5 The Company's tax affairs have been dealt with accordingly. All pre appointment tax returns have been filed with all tax liabilities being discharged. A formal written request has been sent to HMRC for confirmation that there are no outstanding tax matters in relation to the Company.

Other matters

- 2.6 In addition to my responsibility to realise the Company's assets, I am required to comply with various legislative and best practice obligations and deadlines. These obligations include filing of documents with the Registrar of Companies, ensuring that all receipts and payments are promptly dealt with, and proper accounting records are maintained. In addition, I am required to undertake periodic case reviews to monitor progress and deal with any other day to day matters that may arise during the liquidation. Furthermore, where there are creditor claims, I am obliged to advise those creditors of the liquidation and record any claims received.
- 3 Unrealised assets
- 3.1 All assets have now been realised.
- 4 Liabilities

Secured liabilities

4.1 An examination of the Company's mortgage register held by the Registrar of Companies, showed that the Company has not granted any debentures.

Ordinary and secondary preferential creditors
