Directors and Trustees report for the year ended 30th April 2019

The charity's trustees have acted with due regard to the public benefit requirement as set out in the Charity Commission's published guidance on the Public Benefit requirement under the Charities Act. They decided that with regard to the charity's first objective that the first actions of the charity should be to focus on sustainable fashion. To further this benefit the trustees decided that the first focus would be on approaching local state schools to offer courses on sustainable fashion in both primary and secondary.

As stated above Little Hands Design converted from a Community Interest Company to a Charitable Company in September 2018. The change in legal status mid way through the accounting year did not affect the day to day activities.

However charitable status coincided with a planed pause in activities in September 2018. Activities were paused for several months, after the school summer holidays, and since then classes are no longer being held in the Belsize Lane premises but are now held mainly in schools and at the nearby London Mosaic Centre.

As mentioned above charitable status was granted in September 2018 which means that as these accounts have been prepared for the year to 30th April 2019, they only include approximately three months of charitable activities to end of the accounting year.

As the day to day activities were not affected by the change in legal status, some of the activities, achievements and performance of Little Hands Design during the year to 30th April 2019, as mentioned below, had some overlap between the period before and after obtaining charitable status.

Little Hands Design has been active in the following schools in the local area: Eleanor Palmer School, Malorees School and Ark Academy, where places were all funded by Little Hands Design. Children were given an in depth exposure to the ideas of fashion and garment making in the context of sustainability, with weekly calls to action to help them engage and understand the complex issues surrounding the role of fashion within the economy and how to act based on ideas of sustainability.

Little Hands Design has also offered courses at the London School of Mosaic to the wider community. The LSOM is situated within a council housing development and the trustees see this and further cooperation with LSOM where one trustee is also now a governror, to include more tenants there as a continuing goal.

Little Hands Design has supported a young designer with weekly help in administration and more direct technical support.

Structure, governance and management

Little Hands Design is incorporated as a private company limited by guarantee having no share capital and its governing document is its articles of association which were amended on 15th August 2018.

The company's registration number is 10191361 (England & Wales) and its registered office and principal address is 67 Belsize Lane, London, NW3 5AU.

Little Hands Design is registered as a charity under registration number 1180116.

The liability of each member is limited to £1.

New trustees are appointed by the current trustees after considering their expertise with regards to the requirements of the charity.

Objectives and activities

The charity's objectives are the following:-

- 1 To advance for the benefit of the public education in the arts and, in particular (but not limited to), the art of fashion design and garment making.
- 2 To advance in life and help young fashion designers in necessitous circumstances by the provision of studio space and education in fashion design.

Achievements and performance

A summary of the main achivements during the year are as follows:-

Little Hands Design has run weekly courses in 3 state schools, 2 primary and 1 secondary, as proof of concept courses.

Little Hands Design has run weekly Saturday courses at the London School of Mosaic, which are open to local residents.

Little Hands has supported a local designer.

Future plans

Little Hands Design plans to continue running the courses that it carried out by the company whilst it was a CIC and since becoming a charity. However its main focus is to run courses in state schools.

Financial review

The pause in holding courses, coincided with the granting of charitable status and this has meant that very little income was received after charitable status was granted. However ongoing costs meant that for the whole year under review there was a deficit as shown in the income statement.

Income also reduced as less higher earning courses were held as Little Hands Design concentrated more on running courses in schools.

Before deciding to pause the classes the trustees considered the impact this would have on reserves and considered that there were sufficient reserves brought forward to be able to cover this:

The reserve policy is to maintain a general reserve at level which protects Little Hands Design from short term changes to circumstances but at the same time not retaining income longer than necessary.

The Charity has the power to set aside funds for special purposes or as reserves against future expenditure.

The trustees are satisfied with the level of reserves at the reporting date.

Trustees' responsibilities

The trustees (who are also Directors of Little Hands Design for the purposes of company law) are responsible for preparing the trustees report and financial statements in accordance with applicable law and regulations.

Under that law the directors have elected to prepare the financial statements in accordance with United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice (Financial Reporting Standard 102 and applicable law). Under company law the trustees must not approve the financial statements unless they are satisfied that they give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the company and of the profit or loss of the company for that period. In preparing these financial statements, the directors are required to:

- select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently;
- observe the methods and principles in the Charities SORP:
- make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent;
- state whether applicable UK Accounting Standards have been followed, subject to any material departures disclosed and explained in the financial statements:
- prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the company will continue in business.

The trustees are responsible for keeping adequate accounting records that are sufficient to show and explain the company's transactions and disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the company and enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act 2006. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the company and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

1 General information

Little Hands Design is a private company, limited by Guarantee (with no share capital), and registered in England & Wales. Its registered office is 67 Belsize Lane, London, NW3 5AU.

On the 27th September 2018 the company was registered as a charity.

2 Basis of preparation

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the charity's governing document, the Companies Act 2006 and "Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102)" (as amended for accounting periods commencing from 1 January 2016). The charity is a Public Benefit Entity as defined by FRS 102.

The charity has taken advantage of the provisions in the SORP for charities applying FRS 102 Update Bulletin 1 not to prepare a Statement of Cash Flows.

The accounts are prepared in sterling, which is the functional currency of the charity. Monetary amounts in these financial statements are rounded to the nearest \pounds .

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention. The accounts present a true and fair view and no changes have been made to the principal accounting policies adopted below.

Going concern

At the time of approving the accounts, the trustees have a reasonable expectation that the charity has adequate resources to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future. Thus the trustees continue to adopt the going concern basis of accounting in preparing the accounts.

Prior year accounts

In the previous accounting period the company prepared accounts in accordance with the micro-entity provisions. In the period under review, the company was registered as a charity and therefore has prepared these accounts in accordance with the provisions mentioned above. This has not resulted in any prior amounts having to be restated.

Revenue recognition

Income is included in the Statement of Financial Activities (SoFA) when:

- the charity becomes entitled to the resources;
- it is more likely than not that the trustees will receive the resources;
- the monetary value can be measured with sufficient reliability.

The charity's main source of income is from running classes in the furtherance of its objectives. Income from these classes is recognised when the general recognition criteria are met. This is usually when the course fees are received by the charity.

The trustees consider that it would be impractical to calculate any deferred income for course fees received at the accounts year end for courses that had not yet been carried out. The trustees do not consider these amounts to be material.

Grants and donations are only included in the SoFA when the charity has unconditional entitlement to the resources.

Incoming resources from tax reclaims are included in the SoFA at the same time as the gift to which they relate.

Donated goods are measured at fair value (the amount for which the asset could be exchanged) unless impractical to do so.

Little Hands Design often receives gifts of fabric etc, which is used in the courses run by the charity. Due to the impracticality of calculating a fair value these donations are not valued.

The value of any voluntary help received is not included in the accounts.

Expenditure and Liabilities

Liabilities are recognised as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to pay out resources. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis.

No material item of deferred income has been included in the accounts.

The charity has creditors which are measured at settlement amounts.

The charity has incurred expenditure on support costs.

Taxation

Prior to becoming a Charity on the 27th September 2018 the Company had been a CIC and was liable to Taxation.

As a charity the company is exempt from taxation on its charitable activities.

Tangible fixed assets

Tangible fixed assets are capitalised if they can be used for more than one year and are valued at cost or a reasonable value on receipt.

Fixed assets are carried at cost less accumulated depreciation.

Depreciation is calculated so as to write off the cost of an asset, less its
