In the past 12 months, many of our athletes have achieved international success:

- 10 of our athletes competed at the Tokyo Olympic and Paralympic Games.
- 22 of our athletes competed at the 2022 Commonwealth Games.
- 3 of our cyclists competed and medalled at the Track World Champions.
- 1 cyclist achieved the world record for the 1-hour track time trial.
- 2 medals at the para-badminton World Championships.
- 2 medals at the European Aquatics championship.
- 1 footballer representing England at U16

We have grown our athlete programmes to now include a development squad for athletes aged 11 – 13, and a performance prep squad for athletes aged 9-11yrs. We are continuing to grow our Performance Academy which now has 35 athletes.

We have created strong partnerships with two district councils to offer support for their identified talented athletes. These two programmes allow the DIS team to work with a further 80 young people.

We have created a cycling event that will become a yearly feature of our calendar. In 2022, we had 25 competitors, and we are aiming to double this number in 2023.

We have recruited a Business Development Manager (BDM) to help with managing the overall business. The BDM will also lead on a new club affiliation programme which we are aiming to launch in summer 2023.

We enjoyed our 10th anniversary fundraising dinner, which was supported by over 200 guests from the local business community.

We appointed a new member to our Board of Directors – David Nelson, a senior partner for PKF Smith Cooper.
