This CIC is the vehicle for operating the public toilets on Daymer Bay, North Cornwall, PL27 6SA following the cessation of funding by Cornwall Council.

The company was incorporated on 22nd May 2018 and has a board of eight directors. There is an entry charge of 40 pence but, because that level of charging does not cover even the operating costs, we rely on donations to enable us to maintain a very essential service to all users. As part of our ongoing improvements, we are upgrading the coin entry system to accept card payments as well as coin.

The toilets are situated in the car park at Daymer Bay which lies on the North Cornish Path running around the county. Daymer Bay is highly popular with families throughout the year, and the Path is in constant use by walkers, runner and families.

There are no alternative toilets within practical distance of the Bay.

The company is run by its board chosen to provide particular professional skills. We expect to have in excess of 30,000 users per year. On account of the shortfall of entry money not covering operating costs, we have invited local businesses and individuals to make donations to the CIC on the understanding that the provision of these toilets, operated without any practical involvement by them, enhances their businesses and their reputation.
