A Maternity and Neonatal Voices Partnership (MVP or MNVP) brings together service users, staff and other stakeholders to plan, review and improve maternity and neonatal care. It is led by an independent service user representative. MVPs can be extremely effective at ensuring that local services learn from the experiences of local people and at co-producing change. National Maternity Voices (NMV) is the association of MVP leaders who support each other and share ideas.

We established National Maternity Voices CIC in October 2019 with the object of championing the voices of women and families in the development of maternity services. We do this by supporting the work of MVPs, in particular their leaders. It has a small workforce drawn from the MVP community.

Highlights of our work to March 2023 were:

- The launch of the updated Maternity Voices Partnership (MVP) Toolkit and development of a resource bank for MVPs
- Co-producing the 'national support offer' for MVPs
- Monthly video conferences for MVP chairs from September to provide national updates, share good practice and discuss issues.
- Development of multidisciplinary co-production training and training 29 MVP chairs
- Consultancy work including safety related projects.
- Participating in face to face conferences for service user reps and for maternity and neonatal people generally.
- Supporting MVP's work on health inequalities as part of the Health and Wellbeing Alliances' maternity consortium.

Our stakeholders are principally the members of Maternity Voices Partnerships in England, in particular the independent lay chairs. In the year to 31/3/23 we engaged with them on social media via our very active Facebook groups and also on Twitter. We produced 4 public newsletters and also emailed MVP chairs at least monthly. Around 40 chairs were members of the CIC. We held our third general meeting in November 2022. Four NMV council meetings to inform and review the work of the CIC were held and from October all members were invited.

The people that work for NMV are from the MVP community of service user representatives and many are current MVP chairs. We expect everyone to connect with other MVP members and service users in the course of their local, regional or national chair or rep activity alongside work they do for NMV.

We worked closely with the Maternity Transformation team at NHS England who provided funding for MVP support. We submitted news items for their bulletins which go out to Maternity staff around England. We met many members and other stakeholders at face to face conferences in January and March 2023.
