

#### NOTES:

In these Papers Apart 1, 2 and 3:-

BoS means The Governor and Company of the Bank of Scotland;

the Charge means the floating charge by the Company in favour of BoS dated 21 June 2002;

the Company means Lithgows Limited, a company incorporated under the Companies Acts with registered number 10170 and having its registered office at 3 Ardgowan Square, Greenock, Renfrewshire, PA16 8NW;

Secured Assets means the whole of the property (including uncalled capital) which is or may be from time to time comprised in the property and undertaking of the Company; and

Secured Liabilities means all or any monies and liabilities which shall for the time being (and whether on or at any time after demand) be due, owing or incurred in whatsoever manner to BoS by the Company, whether actually or contingently, solely or jointly and whether as principal or surety and whether or not BoS shall have been an original party to the relevant transaction, and including interest, discount, commission and other lawful charges or expenses which BoS may in the course of its business charge or incur in respect of any of those matters or for keeping the Company's account, and so that interest shall be computed and compounded according to the usual BoS rates and practice as well after as before any demand made or decree obtained under the Charge.

The amount secured by the Charge is the Secured Liabilities.

### Paper Apart 2

The property charged by the Charge is the Secured Assets.

## Paper Apart 3

The Company is prohibited from granting or creating subsequent to the date of the Charge any fixed security or any other floating charge (as defined by the Companies Acts 1985) having priority over or ranking pari passu with the Charge, otherwise than in favour of **BoS**.

In the event that the Company grants or creates any fixed security or floating charge in breach of the prohibition above, the Charge shall rank in priority to that fixed security or floating charge.
