The Lord Ordinary, having resumed consideration of the petition and proceedings, no answers having been lodged and on the motion of the petitioner:

1. allows paragraph 8 of the petition to be amended by deletion of the words "the petitioner seeks an order dispensing with the period between 8 September 2014 and the date of restoration in terms of Section 1030 (3) of the Companies Act 2006 against the possibility that the petition might not be granted in time to effect service of the action by 18<sup>th</sup> October 2017" and substituting therefor "A further email from Aviva's representatives dated 17 October 2017 confirmed that a second limitation waiver could be agreed until 18 December 2017"; allows the prayer of the petition to be amended by deletion of the words "and to direct that the period between 8 September 2014 and the making of the said Order shall not count for the purposes of limitation in terms of Section 17 of the Prescription and Limitation (Scotland) Act 1973"; thereafter, dispenses with re-service of the petition as amended;
2. on cause shown, dispenses with service of the petition as amended upon the former directors William Bruce, William Learmonth and Stewart Bain of James Harrison & Co. (Manufacturing Joiners) Limited;
3. orders that James Harrison & Co. (Manufacturing Joiners) Limited (company number SC37163) ("the Company") be restored to the Register of Companies in terms of section 1031 of the Companies Act 2006, such restoration to take effect on a copy of this order being delivered to the Registrar;
4. directs the Registrar of Companies to publish in *The Edinburgh Gazette* notice of the restoration of the Company to the register; and
5. authorises the expenses of this petition and the procedure following thereon, including any expenses to be paid to the Registrar in connection with the proceedings for the restoration of the Company to the register, to be paid out of the first and readiest funds of the Company; and decerns.
