1. Accounting policies

1.1 Basis of preparation of financial statements

The full financial statements, from which these abbreviated accounts have been extracted, have been prepared under the historical cost convention as modified by the revaluation of fixed asset investments and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

1.2 Investments

The company's investment portfolio is intended to be held for use on a continuing basis to provide income and capital growth. The investments are treated as fixed assets and, under the Alternative Accounting Rules, are revalued annually with an adjustment to the company's revaluation reserve. In the case of listed securities the valuation is based on the company's share of net assets.
