- 1. orders that Metech Recycling (UK) Limited, a company incorporated under the Companies Acts (company number SC267543) and having its registered office at JCMS&S, 72 Doonfoot Road, Ayr, KA7 4DP ("the Company") be wound up by the Court under the provisions of the Insolvency Act 1986 ("the 1986 Act");
