#### 1. Accounting Policies

#### Basis of Accounting

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

#### Cash Flow Statement

The director has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard 1 from including a cash flow statement on the grounds that the company is small.

#### <u>Turnover</u>

In accordance with UITF 40 revenue is accrued as service activity takes place reflecting the partial performance of contractual obligations. Turnover is stated net of value added tax (as computed under the Flat Rate Vat Scheme).

#### Depreciation of Tangible Assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset, net of its estimated residual value, over its estimated useful life:
