NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER 2015

1 Accounting policies

1.1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

The company has made a profit this year and has net current assets at the year end. The directors will continue to ensure that sufficient finance is in place to allow the company to meet its financial obligations as and when they become due. In addition, they have agreed to postpone repayment of their directors loan accounts until all other debts are settled in full. Therefore the financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis.

1.2 Turnover

Turnover represents amounts receivable for house furnishing net of VAT and trade discounts.

1.3 Goodwill

Acquired goodwill is written off in equal annual instalments over its estimated useful economic life of 10 years.

1.4 Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets other than freehold land are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:

Land and buildings Freehold

2% Straight Line

Fixtures, fittings & equipment

25% Reducing Balance

Motor vehicles

25% Reducing Balance

1.5 Stock

Stock is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

1.6 Deferred taxation

Deferred tax is provided in full on timing differences which result in an obligation at the balance sheet date to pay more tax, or right to pay less tax, at a future date, at rates expected to apply when they crystallise based on current tax rates and law. Timing differences arise from inclusion of items of income and expenditure in taxation computations in periods different from those in which they are included in the financial statements. Deferred tax assets are recognised to the extent that it is regarded as more likely than not they will be recovered. Deferred tax assets and liabilities are not discounted.

1.7 Operating leases

Rentals payable under operating leases are charged against income on a straight line basis over the lease term.
