1.1 Realisation of assets

1.1.1 Intercompany receivables

Intercompany receivables of £4,844 were due from Aggregated Telecom Limited, a wholly owned subsidiary of Connexions4London Limited. This amount was fully offset against a debt due to Aggregated Telecom Limited for the same amount.

Further intercompany receivables due to Connexions4London Limited of £5,097 were distributed in specie to the shareholder on 24 October 2023.
